Bhakt Darshan Government PG College, the Second Party, and represented herein by Dr. Lovney R. Rajvanshi, Principal, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party' as

WHEREAS:

First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

Maharaja Agrasen Himalayan Garhwal University, Pokhra

Second Party is also is a Higher Educational Institution named:

Bhakt Darshan Government PG College, Jaiharikhal

First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH FOR INDUSTRY INSTITUTE PARTNERSHIP IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

SCOPE OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Both parties believe that close co-operation would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge which in turn could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of the industry. The key areas for mutual cooperation would be:-

1. **Curriculum Design:** Both parties would share the valuable inputs from each other to suitably customize the curriculum to train the students for competitive world.
2. **Exchange of Staff:** The faculty/ research fellows registered for Ph. D program may visit the institute for a short period in connection with their research work under collaborative program.
3. **Joint Workshops/ Conference:** Both the organizations will hold/ conduct joint conference/ workshop/ training courses for students & faculties within the areas of cooperation.
4. **Sharing of Facilities:** Both the organization will to share important R&D facilities in order to promote academic and research in the areas of cooperation. Joint Campus placement drives with pooling of resources.

There is no financial commitment on the part of both the parties to take up any programme mentioned



in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their respective obligations.

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership.

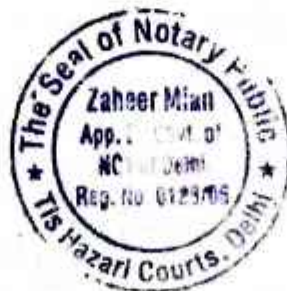

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered on 24-09 day of Saturday 2022 by and between:

<Directorate of Higher Education, Uttarakhand>, situated at Uttarakhand Secretariate, Subhash Road, Dehradun represented by Dr.Sandeep Kumar Sharma, Director, Directorate of Higher Education (hereinafter referred to as "MoU" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorised representatives and permitted assigns) as **FIRST PARTY**.

AND

Naandi Foundation, a Public Charitable Trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882, having its registered office at 502, Trend set Towers, Road No 2, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad – 500 034, Telangana, India represented by Ms. Radha Varadarjan, Chief Skills Officer (hereinafter referred to as "Naandi" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as **SECOND PARTY**.

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as a "Party")

Introduction

WHEREAS The Directorate of Higher Education, Uttarakhand, Nawad Kera, Golapar, Haldwani (Nainital)- 263139 is the nodal and executive body of Higher Education Department for Uttarakhand. It executes, monitors and regulate the policies related to higher education institutes in Uttarakhand.

WHEREAS The first party is willing to provide the student community with employable skill viz. communication skills, soft skills, life skills, domain skills etc. that helps in improving their livelihoods and economic security.

WHEREAS the Second party - Naandi Foundation is an apolitical, autonomous Public Charitable Trust and a not for profit organization having registration under section 12A of income tax act, 1961 is tax exempt and is recognized by tax authorities as an organization established for 'charitable purpose'.

WHEREAS the Second party is working with an objective of people centered development through its charitable activities in whole of India, without distinction of caste, creed or religion, etc.

WHEREAS the Second party engaged, inter alia, in improving the livelihoods of the underprivileged communities through its various social initiatives, development programs in various states of India. The Second Party activities include, education to underprivileged children with a specific focus on girl child education, improving livelihoods of small and marginal farmers through its farming practices, employable training and skill development programs to underprivileged youth, provision of safe drinking water to communities, etc.

WHEREAS the Second party Naandi Foundation in furtherance of its objectives wish to support socially and economically disadvantaged underprivileged sections of the society and provide them employability skills under its "The employability skill development program".

WHEREAS both the parties having recognized each other's intention of working in the sphere of employability skills, wish to support socially and economically disadvantaged and underprivileged students/youth that helps in improving their employability skill set and livelihoods.

WHEREAS both the parties have decided to reduce the mutually agreed terms and conditions into writing.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

I. TERM:

This Memorandum of Understanding is for a period of 1 year and is effective from 24-September-2022 and shall remain in force till 31-March-2022. This MoU may be further extended on terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed by both the parties.

II: THE EMPLOYABILITY SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (MPC)

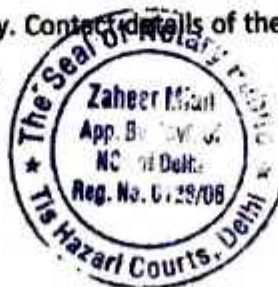
- i. The objective of the program is to impart employability skill set to socially and economically disadvantaged and underprivileged students/youth that helps in improving livelihoods and economic security.
- ii. The beneficiaries shall be from underprivileged sections of society without distinction of caste, creed or religion etc., and shall be studying in the pre-final year courses in Government Degree Colleges in the State of across Uttarakhand.
- iii. The program shall be for a duration of 40 hours to 120 hours or as the case may be decided mutually by the parties.
- iv. The program shall include New Age skills, Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview Preparations for the beneficiaries under employability skill development program. The beneficiaries may be trained in any other skill as mutually decided by both the parties that improves their livelihoods.

III: OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY (Department of Higher Education, Uttarakhand)

- i. The first party shall provide the beneficiaries under the said program and shall ensure that they are underprivileged students/youth studying in pre-final year of Under Graduate and Post Graduate course in the said institution/college.
- ii. Ensure that the necessary infrastructure like well-equipped class rooms and or Computer labs as per course requirements are made available where the program shall be implemented.
- iii. Ensure to identify one resource person (hereinafter referred to as POC - Point of Contact) from their faculty group to co-ordinate between the beneficiaries, the Institute management and the Second Party. Contact details of the POC shall be shared with the Second party and rest of the team.

- iv. Ensure that the Government Degree Colleges shall allow Naandi's employees, representatives and trainers during the sustenance of this MoU, to interact with POC, program related staff and beneficiaries.
- v. POC should ensure that all the underprivileged youth/students are given an awareness on attending employability skill training program prior to the training and encourage them to register for the said program.
- vi. POC should monitor trainee's attendance on a daily basis.
- vii. Ensure that the basic training requirements like Black/White board, Chalk/Marker, A4 sheets, Projector and screen should be available during training sessions.
- viii. Ensure that the POC should take feedback from the trainees for quality assurance purpose.

IV: OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY (NAANDI):

- i. To impart employability skill to socially and economically disadvantaged and underprivileged students/youth that helps in improving livelihoods and economic security.
- ii. Prepare content that will be most effective in training the beneficiaries/students.
- iii. To Provide the first party a detailed Course Schedule.
- iv. Ensure that well-trained trainers are identified and deployed to ensure overall success of the Program.
- v. Ensure to give an update on employability training program and its importance to the training coordinator of the First Party.
- vi. Monitor the program by conducting periodic assessments to ensure that the trainers do a quality job.

V. FREE OF COST:

The socially and economically disadvantaged and underprivileged students/youth are provided with employability skill set under "The Employability Skill Development Program", to improve their

livelihoods and economic security. The Program is free of cost. Either party shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the beneficiaries under the program. Further, both the parties agree that either party shall not charge any fees whatsoever from the other party under this MoU/program.

VI. CERTIFICATION:

Certificates shall be awarded by the second party to the beneficiaries on successful completion of the training having attendance above 80 percentages and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the program.

VII. GENERAL TERMS:

i. **Relationship between the parties:**

Nothing herein shall be construed to constitute the Parties as principal and agent, employer and employee, partners or joint ventures, nor shall any similar relationship be deemed to exist between the Parties. This Memorandum of Understanding is made on principal-to-principal basis.

ii. **Representation and Warranties:**

Each Party hereby represents to the other that they have been duly incorporated/registered under the applicable laws and has full legal right and authority to execute this memorandum of understanding. Each Party represents that it is also authorized to perform its obligations as herein contemplated; and that neither the performance of the obligations or execution of this MoU will violate or in violation of any applicable laws for the time being in force.

iii. **Confidentiality:**

The parties shall severally take care to ensure that the information provided by the other party remains confidential and further agree not to use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which it is intended. The parties shall not disclose any Confidential Information to anyone other than the employees of either organization who need to know the Confidential Information. Each Party recognizes such information of the other Party as confidential information and agrees not to disclose them to any third party without the prior written consent of the other Party. The restriction contained in this clause shall not be applicable to information which (i) is required to be provided pursuant to any statutory or regulatory obligation; (ii) is lawfully acquired by the disclosing Party from an independent source having no obligation to maintain the confidentiality of such Information; and (iii) was lawfully known to the disclosing Party prior to its disclosure under this Agreement.

Intellectual Property:

Each Party acknowledges the intellectual property rights of any kind, including but not limited to copyright, patent rights, design rights, service marks, trademarks, logos, titles, slogans, property rights and any other rights, held by the other Party and undertake that neither Party shall claim any right, title and interest in the Intellectual Property Rights of the other Party.

v. **Dispute Resolution:**

If any dispute arises between the Parties, the Parties shall endeavor to resolve them mutually. If such resolution is not possible within a reasonable period, the unresolved dispute shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Act for the time being in force, conducted by a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Parties mutually. The arbitration shall be in English and the seat of the arbitration shall be at Hyderabad. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

vi. **Validity of Clauses:**

If any Clause or any part this Agreement shall for any reason be adjudged by any court or other legal authority of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

vii. **Entire Agreement:**

This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the Parties at the date hereof relating to the Purpose and supersedes any prior agreements or arrangements (whether oral or in writing) between the Parties relating thereto.

viii. **Notices:**

All notices, which either Party is required or may desire to serve upon the other Party, shall be in writing and addressed as specified in the recital of this Agreement. Notices may be served personally or by facsimile, certified mail, express mail, email to a designated employee of the Party or express courier.

ix. **Termination:**

Either of the parties is entitled to terminate this MoU by giving a thirty days' notice to other party in case of breach of any term of this MoU by the other party, provided, that before issuing such termination notice, such issues shall be discussed with senior officials of the Parties and if they fail to resolve such issues within a period of fifteen (15) days, then it shall result in termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

x. Force Majeure:

Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the Majeure event such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, pandemic, riots, civil commotion, etc., provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the Party effected thereby shall give a notice in writing to other Party within one (1) month of such occurrence or cessation. If force majeure continues beyond one (1) month, the parties shall jointly and mutually decide about the future course of action or terminate this MoU with immediate effect.

xi. Amendment:

Any term or terms of this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended/modified or changed in writing with mutual consent of both the parties.

xii. Assignment and Delegation:

Neither this Memorandum of Understanding nor any duties or obligations under this Agreement may be assigned or delegated by either party.

xiii. Governing Laws and Jurisdiction:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed by laws of India and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts situated at Hyderabad.

xiv. Rules of Interpretation:

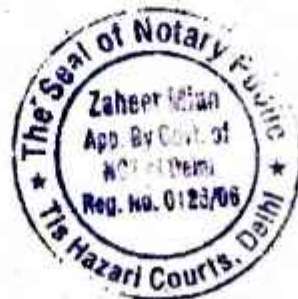

This Memorandum of understanding shall be executed in two counterparts each of which shall be deemed as original, but all of this together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

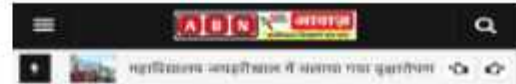

The Department of Higher Education hereinafter referred to as DoHE, Government of Uttarakhand, is committed to fulfilling the government's intention to make higher education universally accessible. The government is making efforts to provide a high-quality education system with state-of-the-art resources in the institutions of higher learning in the state. At the same time, special emphasis is being laid by the government on providing entrepreneurship and vocational education to the students so that the youth can become self-reliant and make invaluable contributions to the prosperity and progress of the state.

Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, hereinafter referred to as EDII, having its office at Bhat, Gandhinagar, Gujarat, a not-for-profit institute, set up in 1983, is promoted by apex financial institutions, the IDBI Bank Ltd., ICICI Bank Ltd., IFCI Ltd. and the State Bank of India. It is a Government of Gujarat-owned autonomous body. The Institute is registered under the Societies Registration Act - 1860 and Public Trust Act - 1950. EDII is based near village Bhat, Dist. Gandhinagar, Gujarat. The vision of the Institute is **'To emerge as a global leader in entrepreneurship education, research, development and institution-building to spearhead the growth of entrepreneurial leadership'**.

Broad Objectives and Scope:

Given the potential, the state of Uttarakhand can significantly bolster entrepreneurship development on campuses of higher learning. The state has launched the Start-Up Policy 2018 to encourage entrepreneurs and generate employment opportunities in the state. Amidst such a proactive environment, where efforts need to be put in to complement all endeavours towards promoting entrepreneurship in universities & college campuses through focused initiatives.

The National Education Policy 2020, announced by the Ministry of Education, Govt of India also addresses the key issues for education at all levels; school education, higher education as well as professional and vocational lines of education.

The purpose of this MOU, between DHE, GoUK and EDII, therefore, is to support the state in building one of the most start-up-friendly destinations in India by promoting entrepreneurship education, policy research and incubation support in higher learning institutions. Under this MoU the EDII will:

- a) conduct Sensitization Workshops for Vice-Chancellors, Principals, Leading Educationists & Govt. Officials;
- b) establish 'Centres of Excellence' on various themes (Religious Tourism; Wellness & AYUSH; Medicinal, Aromatic Rare Herbs; Women Entrepreneurship; Fisheries; Cow Based Entrepreneurship etc.) in different institutions of Higher learning
- c) develop 'Students' Start-up and Innovation Policy' for the State;
- d) conduct Faculty Development Programmes on 'Start-up Entrepreneurship and Incubation' for University and College Teachers;
- e) develop and Designing Courses on Entrepreneurship to be introduced as regular subjects/ modules at University/ College level;
- f) create Awareness about entrepreneurial careers among students and youth of the State;
- g) establish Entrepreneurship Development Cells at Universities/Leading Higher Learning Educational Campuses;
- h) promote start-ups and innovations through training, counselling and mentoring by setting up Incubation Centre/s and Entrepreneurship Development Centre;
- i) organise Mega Start-up Events and Exhibitions as a signature event for the state;
- j) organise Regional Start-ups and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Awareness Events;

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- k) support institutions in conducting programmes and activities as per the requirements of the Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) and the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cells (MIIC);
- l) develop Project Profiles on emerging business opportunities (such as; Ethno-Religious Tourism, AYUSH and Wellness; Logistics; IT and ITeS; Pharmaceuticals etc.) and making these available to the students;
- m) develop and distribute success stories/video films on entrepreneurs;
- n) support Universities and Institutions in leveraging on Tourist Circuits of State, Agro-climatic Conditions, Healthcare & and wellness Food processing sectors etc.
- o) develop newer ways to generate employment through Innovative enterprises/Startups that may help people earn alternate livelihoods during Off Business Seasons in State.
- p) facilitate GoUK through Innovative Proposal and Concepts Notes in bringing Funds/resources from the Centrally Sponsored Programmes and Schemes.

Action Plan:

In order to achieve the above-mentioned objectives, the Department of Higher Education (DHE), GoUK and EDII mutually agree to take the following actions.

A. Policy Creation and Knowledge Product Development

- Creation of 'Student Start-up and Innovation Policy
- Development and distribution of success stories/video films on entrepreneurs
- Creation of Project Profiles on emerging business opportunities (such as Ethno-Religious Tourism, AYUSH and Wellness; Logistics; IT and ITeS; Pharmaceuticals etc.) and make these available to the students

B. Faculty Leadership Development

- Conduction of Sensitization Workshops for Vice-Chancellors, Principals, Leading Educationists & Govt. Officials
- Faculty Leadership Development Programmes on 'Start-up Entrepreneurship and Incubation' for University and College Teachers;

C. Entrepreneurship and Vocational Courses (NEP Implementation)

- Development and Launch of Regular Courses, subjects/ modules at the University/ College level on Entrepreneurship
- Establishment of Entrepreneurship Development Cells at Universities/Leading Higher Learning Educational Campuses;

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- Supporting Universities and Institutions in leveraging on Tourist Circuits of State, Agro-climatic Conditions, Healthcare & and wellness Food processing sectors etc.
- Supporting institutions in conducting programmes and activities as per the requirements of the Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) and the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cells (MIIC);

D. Establishment of Centres of Excellence

- Establishment of 'Centres of Excellence' on various themes in different institutions of Higher learning:
 - Religious Tourism;
 - Wellness & AYUSH;
 - Medicinal, Aromatic Rare Herbs;
 - Women Entrepreneurship;
 - Fisheries;
 - Cow Based Entrepreneurship
 - Others

E. State Signature Events (Startup, Investment and Skill Development):

- Organising Mega Start-up Events, Exhibitions and Investors' Meet as a Signature event for the state

F. Pre-Incubation Activities across the state

- Creating Awareness among students and youth of the State about entrepreneurial opportunities and careers;
- Organising Regional Start-ups and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Awareness Events;
- Promoting start-ups and innovations through training, counselling and mentoring intervention;

G. Collaboration and Agreements for Student Internship

- Regional meetings will be organised to host Senior Indian Administrative Services Officials from Uttarakhand who are serving other State Governments and have key portfolios. Through these meetings, opportunities will be explored for interstate collaborations, student's internship and exchange, faculty exchange, joint research, joint technology development and investment in Education Sector in Uttarakhand.
- Forging collaborations and MoUs with leading Incubators, Investors, Industry Associations, Enterprises and Entrepreneurship Ecosystem players for internship and developmental initiatives
- Bringing technology, innovations, resources and market that would help emerging entrepreneurs grow and sustain.

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H. Bringing Funds from the Centre to State

- Facilitating through Innovative Proposals and Concept Notes in bringing Funds/ resources from the Centrally Sponsored Programmes and Schemes.

I. Setting up of Entrepreneurship Development Institute for Hilly Regions:

- Setting up 'Entrepreneurship Development Institute for Hilly Regions' to create start-ups, innovative and traditional enterprises that can sustain, grow and create jobs

After mutual agreement, EDII will develop proposals, including financial, and submit the same to the authorised official/s in the DoHE, GoUK for consideration. Also, EDII will be excluded from any bidding/tendering processes, and works will be assigned to EDII on a nomination basis from the Government of Uttarakhand.

Confidentiality

The Department and EDII agree to treat all information as confidential and will not share/disclose any information, knowledge or material to any third party. This MoU creates a confidential relationship between the Department and EDII to protect any type of confidential and proprietary information or trade secrets.

Termination Clause

The agreement can be terminated at any point in time with mutual consent without any liability to either party. This AGREEMENT is hereby accepted and agreed to by authorized representatives.

Duration

This MoU will remain in force initially for a period of 5 years and will be further continued as may be mutually agreed upon between the Government of Uttarakhand and EDII.

Applicable law, Jurisdiction and Arbitration

The Government of Uttarakhand and EDII shall use mutual consultation for resolving differences/disputes amicably within 30 calendar days from the date of return notice by either party. Any further differences arising between the parties and which cannot be settled mutually shall be referred to arbitration. The Arbitrator shall be mutually




Identified by the Government of Uttarakhand and EDII. The proceedings shall be governed under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act – 1966.

Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in its performance or non-performance due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control including but not limited to circumstances such as; acts of GOD, war, flood, earthquake, riots, civil commotion, state embargoes, strikes, etc. However, one party shall inform the other of such a situation as soon as practicable. If Force Majeure condition continues beyond three months, the parties shall mutually decide about the future course of action.



CHALLENGES

EDPs are a potential solution to boost entrepreneurship and also contribute to the motivation of prospective entrepreneurs. People assume that EDPs will solve all the issues of entrepreneurship. Lack of understanding and non-clarity of the objectives limit their growth. There are the following challenges, misconceptions or myths:

- Most budding entrepreneurs lacking cognitive part of the entrepreneurship.
- Crises of resources in developing entrepreneurship eco system in hilly terrain.
- Biggest challenge is the lacking knowledge of legal aspects of business.
- Challenge is to provide continued support in Marketing of inputs and Marketing of outputs.
- Most prospective entrepreneurs believe that mere joining an entrepreneurial development programme will solve all their problems.
- People consider EDPs as training programs, whereas training is one part of the EDPs. It also covers other aspects of entrepreneurship.
- People often link the success of EDPs with the number of participants. There is a myth about EDPs that higher the number, better the EDP.
- Participants think that the success of EDPs is the sole responsibility of trainers, motivators, and organisers.
- Huge financial support to organisers and trainers. Whereas, these are national income and public money.

Waste the resources, as they belong to the government, and the government is responsible for managing all the resources
